



As we are still under necessary safety precautions due to COVID-19 we are prioritizing one-on-one time with residents. We have enhanced our activity stations to include peg-boards, coloring, magnet tiles, sorting activities and aqua-painting — just to name a few. Team members are focusing more on bringing out these stations as they find residents searching for something to do. We have also been utilizing technology with our in-house closed-circuit TV channel on the common area TVs. Through this channel residents can watch exercise classes, concerts, church services, nature presentations, brain training seminars and educational lectures. We have also set up laptops when appropriate to show videos about residents' personal interests. We have added a seek-


